

JMRC MEDICAL FITNESS STANDARDS

Candidates recommended for interview and/or medical examination will have to pass medical fitness test(s) conducted by agencies/medical authorities nominated for the purpose by JMRC. The tests are intended to ensure that the candidates are medically fit in all respects to carry out the job responsibilities related to a post. No person will be deemed qualified for the service of JMRC if he/she does not satisfy the appointing authority that he/she has no disease, constitutional affliction or bodily infirmity unfitting him/her, or likely to unfit him/her for the post. Visual acuity standard is one of the most important criteria of medical fitness for metro operations.

Medical Fitness Test(s):

- a. All candidates shall have to undergo the medical fitness test(s) and meet the medical standards prescribed by JMRC for various posts.
- b. During the course of service, all employees shall have to undergo periodical medical fitness test(s) as may be prescribed by JMRC from time to time and their continuance on the post will be subject to their meeting the medical standards prescribed for the post.
- c. Expenses for medical fitness test of the candidates for the purpose of determining their suitability for the post (and, if appointed, continuance thereon) will be borne by JMRC. However, in case a candidate seeks extension for joining, the cost of such test will be borne by the candidate himself/ herself.
- d. Candidates who fail in the prescribed medical fitness test will not be given any alternative employment.
- e. The decision of JMRC as to whether a candidate meets the prescribed Medical Standard shall be final and binding.

Standards of Medical Examination

- a. For the purpose of physical fitness and visual acuity standards, the non-managerial posts in JMRC will be grouped in different Classes (A-1, A-2, A-3, B-1, B-2, C-1, C-2) on the pattern of classification of non-gazetted staff used in Indian Railways.
- b. The medical standards for different Classes will be such as are prescribed by Indian Railways for the relevant Class. The medical fitness test(s) to determine fitness for various Classes will be on the pattern of medical examination prescribed in Chapter 5 of the [Indian Railway Medical Manual \(IRMM\)](#).



- c. Class-wise medical standards for appointment to different non-managerial posts are briefly outlined below:-
- i. **A-1**
Physically fit in all respects. Visual Standards - Distance Vision: 6/6, 6/6 without glasses/contact lens. Near Vision: Sn: 0.6, 0.6 without glasses/contact lens (must clear fogging test). Colour Vision, Binocular Vision & Night Vision must be present. Field of Vision must not be restricted.
 - ii. **A-2**
Physically fit in all respects. Visual Standards - Distance Vision: 6/9, 6/9 without glasses/ contact lens. Near Vision: Sn: 0.6, 0.6 without glasses/contact lens. Colour Vision, Binocular Vision & Night Vision must be present. Field of Vision must not be restricted.
 - iii. **A-3**
Physically fit in all respects. Visual Standards - Distance Vision: 6/9, 6/9 with or without glasses (power not to exceed $\pm 2D$). Near Vision: Sn: 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses. Colour Vision, Binocular Vision & Night Vision must be present. Field of Vision must not be restricted.
 - iv. **B-1**
Physically fit in all respects. Visual Standards - Distance Vision: 6/9, 6/12 with or without glasses (power not to exceed $\pm 4D$). Near Vision: Sn: 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required. Colour Vision, Binocular Vision & Night Vision must be present.
 - v. **B-2**
Physically fit in all respects. Visual Standards - Distance Vision: 6/9, 6/12 with or without glasses (power not to exceed $\pm 4D$). Near Vision: Sn: 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required. Colour Vision, Binocular Vision & Night Vision must be present.
 - vi. **C-1**
Physically fit in all respects. Visual Standards - Distance Vision: 6/12, 6/18 with or without glasses. Near Vision: Sn: 0.6, 0.6 with or without glasses when reading or close work is required.
 - vii. **C-2**
Physically fit in all respects. Visual Standards - Distance Vision: 6/12, Nil with or without glasses. Near Vision: Sn: 0.6 combined with or without glasses when reading or close work is required.
- d. The above medical standards (criteria) are indicative and not exhaustive. e. The classification of different non-managerial posts in JMRC will be as under: -

Station Controller/ Train Operator	Aye-1 (A-1)
Junior Engineer (Civil)	Aye-3 (A-3)
Junior Engineer (Electrical)	Aye-3 (A-3)
Junior Engineer (Mechanical)	Aye-3 (A-3)
Junior Engineer (Electronics)	Aye-3 (A-3)
Customer Relations Assistant	Bee-1 (B-1)
Maintainer (Fitter)	Bee-1 (B-1)
Maintainer (Electrician)	Bee-1 (B-1)
Maintainer (Electronics)	Bee-1 (B-1)
Maintainer (Refrigeration & AC)	Bee-1 (B-1)

f. JMRC may classify and/or lay down standards for other posts from time to time.
